

Canada - Accord commercial avec l'UE pourrait augmenter les exportations des myrtilles

Rémy Lambert, Professor at Laval University, says that the trade agreement with the EU could boost the Canadian blueberry industry. 80% of the Canadian blueberry production is currently exported, some of it in form of processed products for which high import duties have to be paid. The completion of the FTA could give opportunities to Canadian growers while the US is still negotiating its own agreement with the EU.

The final text of the trade agreement is currently finalised by the EU and Canada and could enter into force in late 2014 or early 2015.
