

Ukraine: prices of vegetables and fruit kept low

The most popular goods in the wholesale market in Kiev are potatoes. Greengrocers are glad that the demand is getting higher due to the coming winter, but the prices are not increasing.

Onions cost 0.15 Euro per kilogram on the market; potatoes, beetroot, carrots are of the same price. Garlic prices vary from 0.6 to 0.8 Euro, tomatoes start from 0.17, pepper - from 0.4 euro per kilo. The prices of local fruit have not increased either. The stock of goods is sufficient, thus prices are unlikely to rise, - assume the market participants.

Besides, according to experts, the potato yield in Ukraine is expected to hit the record this year, which can result in the price drop.
