

Accord d'association UE/Ukraine est entré en vigueur le 1er Janvier 2016

The Deep and Comprehensive Free Trade Area (DCFTA), which is part of the Association Agreement between the European Union and Ukraine and had been signed in June 2014, came into force at the 1st of January 2016. This is expected to result into a more stable, diversified and developed Ukrainian economy, which shall also lead to further approximation of Ukrainian competition, government procurement and intellectual property right legislation to the European policies. Moreover shall this lead to lower prices and better access to high quality products for the Ukrainian consumers. For EU member states the DCFTA will allow access to a market with more than 45 mio. people.
