

USA, China, Brazil and Japan, main destinations of European Olive Oil in the first month of the Campaign

The United States, China, Brazil and Japan have been the main destinations for olive oil and olive pomace oil in October 2016, the first month of the current 2016/17 campaign, according to the latest data from the European Commission (EC). Australia, Canada, Morocco, Tunisia, Egypt and Turkey are other countries to which European exports of these products have been directed.

Specifically, member states have exported a total of 59,334 tons to third countries in October (+39.9% more than the same month a year earlier), of which 22,008 tons have been shipped to the United States (+43,6%).

This destination is followed by China (5,147 t., +13.9%); Brazil (4,566 t., +62.5%); Japan (3,899 t., +53.2%); Canada (3,537 t., +106.1%); Australia (3,077 t., +75.4%); Morocco (216 t., +21.3%); and Turkey (58 t., -10.7%).

As far as imports are concerned, data from the EU executive show that the EU imported a total of 7,773 tons during that month, 55.4% less than in October 2015, of which 4,364 tons came from Tunisia (-61,5%); 1,445 tons from Syria (compared to 18 tons during last year's month of October); and 376 tons from Turkey (+283%).
