

## Egypt: Agricultural exports in 2017 increased to \$ 2.2 billion

According to a report by the Agricultural Export Council, Egypt's agricultural exports increased by 3 percent in 2017 to a record sum of \$ 2.2 billion, compared to \$ 2.1 billion in 2016.

The Chairman of the Agricultural Export Council, Abdel Hamid al-Dermdash, said that citrus, potato, onion, garlic, and fruits' exports took in \$ 523.23 million, \$270.38 million, \$ 215.54 million and \$ 335.03 million respectively, during the first 11 months of 2017.

According to an [egypttoday.com](http://egypttoday.com) article, 10 countries took in 65 percent of the sector's exports, Russia coming first with \$ 290.52 million, followed by Saudi Arabia with \$ 286.68 million and Holland with \$ 143.41 million.
