

Ukraine exported twelve times more button mushrooms in 2017

In 2017, Ukraine exported 533 tons of button mushrooms worth USD 480,000, according to the press service of the Ministry of Agrarian Policy and Food of Ukraine.

This is 12.5 times the export number of 2016, when Ukraine exported 42.6 tons of button mushrooms to foreign markets, worth USD 37,800.

Ukrinform.net reports how the largest importers of Ukrainian of mushrooms have been Moldova (443 tons worth \$382,000), Belarus (85.4 tons worth \$87,100) and Romania (1 ton worth \$1,500).

Ukrainian mushrooms have been also supplied to Israel, Georgia, Kuwait, Austria, Panama, Slovakia, Turkey and others.
