



Norwegian salmon exports hit August record

Norwegian salmon exports hit the 100,000 tonne mark last month – a record for August 2018. Demand continues to be strong, said the Norwegian Seafood Council.

Salmon earned the country's fish farmers NOK six billion (GBP 556 million), a rise of nine per cent on a year ago, while export volumes were up by 10,500 tonnes or 12 per cent.

So far this year, Norway has exported 672,000 tonnes of salmon with a value of NOK 43.8 billion (GBP 4 billion).

Gitte Hannemann Mollan, the Norwegian Seafood Council representative in Germany and Poland, said: 'Poland was our largest growth market for salmon last month, increasing by NOK 136 million, or 19 per cent.
