

Fishermen produced more than 916 thousand tons - almost 13% more than in 2019

According to the industry monitoring system, by March 4, 2020, the total catch of aquatic biological resources by Russian users amounted to 916.37 thousand tons, which is almost 103.7 thousand tons, or 12.8%, more than last year.

In the Far Eastern fisheries basin, production increased by 15.1% and reached 705.68 thousand tons. In the Pollock fishery, the catch amounted to 555.4 thousand tons, which is almost 71.7 thousand tons higher than last year, cod was 11 thousand tons more - 37.63 thousand tons, herring - 2.32 thousand tons more 56.11 thousand tons.

In the Northern Fisheries Basin, fishery managers increased their catch by almost 20% compared to last year - up to 89.68 thousand tons. About 66.4 thousand tons were produced in the cod fishery - 9.72 thousand tons more, haddock catch increased by 3.4 thousand tons - up to almost 14 thousand tons.



In the Western Fisheries Basin, the volume of extraction of aquatic biological resources amounted to 15.35 thousand tons, which is 1.8% less than last year. In the sprat field, 9.36 thousand tons were developed, which is 0.9 thousand tons less than last year. The catch of Baltic herring amounted to about 5.8 thousand tons - 0.8 thousand tons more.

In the Azov-Black Sea fisheries basin, more than 4.4% more than last year's figure - 16 thousand tons. In the hamsa fishery, the catch increased by 2 thousand tons, up to almost 14.7 thousand tons. In the tyulka fishery, the catch amounted to 0.35 thousand tons, which is 0.72 thousand tons less than last year.

3.66 thousand tons were mined in the Volga-Caspian fishery basin, which is 2.98 thousand tons more than last year. Sprat catch amounted to 3.15 thousand tons, which is 3.13 thousand tons more than last year. The volume of production of freshwater species of aquatic biological resources amounted to 0.44 thousand tons, which is 0.07 thousand tons less than last year.

In areas of foreign countries, the Russian fishing fleet increased its catch by 5.1%, to 53.2 thousand tons. In the convention areas and the open part of the World Ocean, 31.8 thousand tons were mined, which is almost 24% less than last year.
