

## Anchovy fishing records advance of 23% of assigned quota for the first season of 2020

**Produce indicated that this season it complies with the health and safety measures established in the regulations. The percentage of juveniles of the anchovy resource extracted to date averages 6.98%.**

The Ministry of Production (Produce) reported that, to date, during the first anchovy fishing season in the year, a catch of 556,649 tonnes has been recorded.

This result represents 23.07% of the total catch quota, which amounts to 2.41 million tons.

Produce indicated that this season it complies with the health and safety measures established in the regulations.

The optimal fishing area is located in front of the ports of Malabrigo - Chicama (La Libertad) to Huarney (Áncash), causing the landings to be made in the ports of Malabrigo, Coishco, Chimbote, Supe, Vegueta, Carquín, Callao and Tambo from Mora.

The extractive activity or fishing effort is carried out by 229 fishing vessels from the steel fleet (Decree Law 25977) and 84 from the wood fleet (Law 26920).

Taking care of the sustainability concept of the anchovy resource, to date 28 fishing zones have been suspended between Supe - Lima in the north to Paracas-Ica in the south, for which the information received from the captains of the E / P is analyzed. through the electronic log system.

It should be pointed out that the percentage of juveniles from the anchovy resource extracted to date averages 6.98%.
