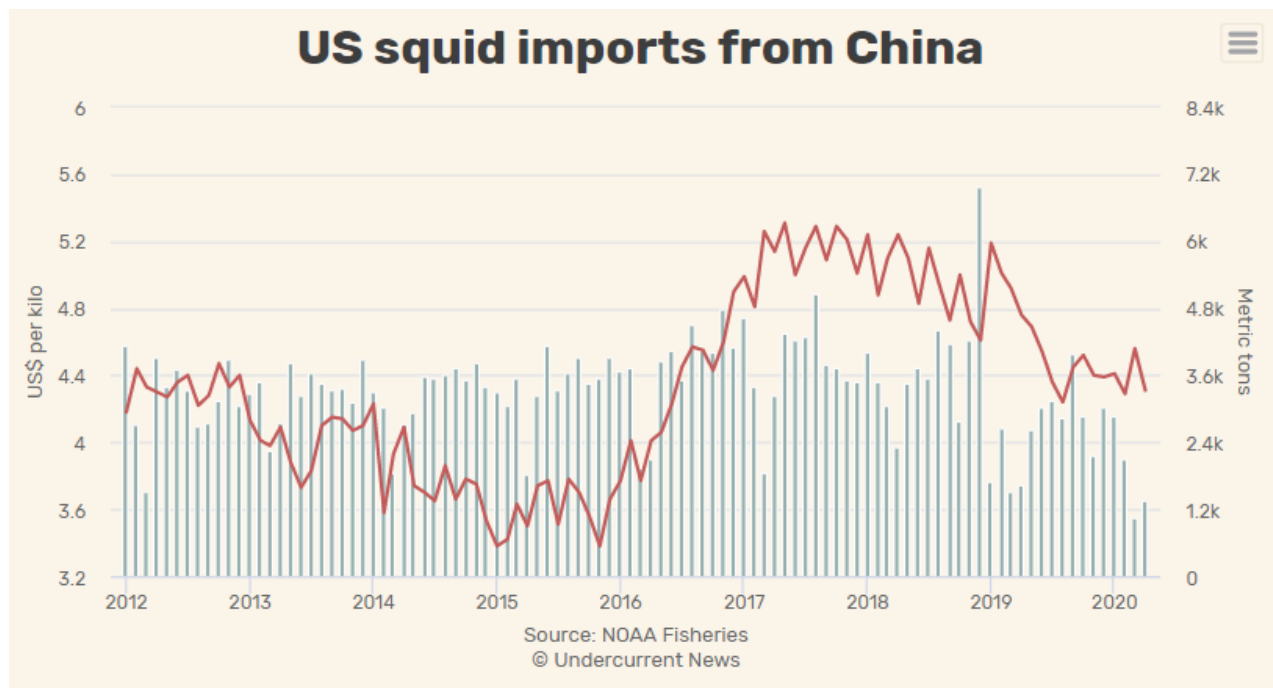


US imports of Chinese squid at lowest in past decade

According to data from the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, during the first four months of 2020, the US imported 7,396 metric tons of Chinese squid worth \$33 million, down 43% in volume and down 8% in value, year-on-year.

March and April figures represent the US' lowest imports of Chinese squid by volume for the last decade.



Import volumes did rise month-on-month in April, from 1,045t to 1,369t. The average unit value, however, fell back to levels seen in February, after a brief lift in March — to \$4.31 per kilogram.
